

How to use the Audit & Strategy

Like any area of ministry there can be a danger of carrying on the same way simply because "that's the way things have always been done." However, life brings changes, society adapts & our lives change as a result.

Our recent history has created many changes to family life and indeed family engagement with church, as a result the church body also needs to adapt and change. So it is vital that we review, reflect & reconfigure where necessary.

We would encourage you to do an Audit and Strategy plan on an annual basis, and if this is the first time you have completed such a task it might seem a little scary - but don't worry, it's a lot more straight forward than it seems.

On the following pages are a series of questions covering all angles of your church's interaction with families. The aim is to help bring focus to your discussions, guidance to your plans and to inspire new ideas and ways of doing things.



You know your church and your community, you know the people and the resources you have. Whilst we encourage you to dream big dreams we also want you to be realistic and set attainable goals each year.

Where possible gather a group together of those who are involved in the ministry of your church. If you are blessed with Children and Family staff or volunteers do this together as a team. If you are clergy and currently have no team maybe consider doing this as part of a vestry meeting, or put the call out to those you think may have an interest in developing Children and Families ministry in your community. Be bold - every seed has to be planted somewhere in order to grow!

Top Tips:

- Do not be defensive! Allow constructive feedback. It's not easy especially when you are the one putting the effort in, but in order to grow we need to be challenged.
- Ask local families what their impression is of your church - why do / don't they come, what would they change if they could?
- Spend time viewing family life in your community - where do families spend most time, what activities / places are most popular,

 - 9. If liturgy is used, are special instructions given to help children follow it?
 - 10. Are some of the hymns or songs chosen specifically with children in mind?
 - 11. How often are children or children's issues used as a topic for prayer?
- 12. Are there services especially for children and their families? How are they different from other services?
 - 13. How are children's voices heard in the planning and delivery of your services and how are their gifts used and nurtured?
- What conclusions do you draw from your discussions around how Our Services can have an impact on the welcome and inclusion of children and their families?

Our Activities

Use these questions to help you take a closer look at what activities you provide for the discipleship of children and families in your church community.

Think too of those children and families in the wider community who are not yet part of your church.

How do you disciple children and their families and nurture their spiritual development?

Draw up a list of all the activities your church gets up to. Include Sunday clubs, weekly activities, occasional events and regular annual events.

- 1. Along side each activity, note who it is for. E.g., families, children only, the whole church, the wider community, 'church children only', etc.
- 2. Which activities are for people who do not yet see themselves as 'members' of your church?
 - 3. Are there activities specifically for families to come along to together?
 - 4. How do people hear about these activities and know they are welcome to come to them?
 - 5. Could any current activities be developed further using the gifts people in your church community possess?
 - 6. How do you equip, resource and support your children and family leaders?
 - 7. How are the voices of children heard in the planning and running of these activities?
 - 8. What conclusions do you draw from your discussions around how Our Activities can have an impact on the welcome and inclusion of children and their families?
 - 9. Are there any areas you can identify where you might want to suggest a new course of action?

Our Facilities

Use these questions to help you look at the facilities you have, how accessible they are to children and to families with young children, and how well they are being used. See this as an opportunity to identify areas which can be adapted and improved.

- 1. How comfortable do you feel in your church buildings?
- 2. How easy is it for small children to enter your church building? Are there any hazards or difficulties you can identify?
 - 3. How easy is it for a pram, pushchair or wheel chair to be brought into your church building?
 - 4. Where can you 'park' buggies or prams during the service?
- 5. Where can a parent change a dirty nappy? What facilities do you offer for this?
- 6. How does your church congregation respond to breast feeding during a service or gathering?
 - 7. Do you have the facilities to warm a baby's bottle?
- 8. What are you able to offer a parent with a toddler to help them engage with the service?
- 9. Can young children reach the urinal, toilet, sinks, soap, hand dryer/paper towels?
 - 10. How easy is it for a newcomer to find the toilets in your church building?
 - 11. How warm is your church in the winter?
 - 12. How often is a risk assessment of your buildings carried out?
 - 13. How are children's voices heard in relation to the facilities you have and how they are used?

What conclusions do you draw from your discussions around how Our Facilities can have an impact on the welcome and inclusion of children and their families?

Are there any areas you can identify where you might want to suggest a new course of action?

Our People

These questions are designed to get you thinking about how people of the church make children and their families feel welcome.

- 1. Can you think of a time when you were made to feel very welcome and wanted somewhere? What were the things that made a difference to you?
 - 2. In your church, who is responsible for welcoming children and their families?
 - 3. Where does the welcome begin?
 - 4. Discuss the reception you think a new family turning up at your church this Sunday would get. How would they know that you were really glad to be welcoming them?
 - 5. What does a good welcome 'look like'?
 - 6. Who do you expect to give an 'official welcome' to children and families, especially if they are new to your church?
 - 7. What training is given to those who provide an 'official welcome'?

 Think of your Church Wardens at the doors for example.
- 8. How often are church members reminded and encouraged to be welcoming to children and their families?
- 9. Does your church have a mission statement? What does is say about children and families?
 - 10. How are the voices of children heard and used in this area?
 - 11. Is there a culture of ensuring thatpeople are not left on their own (or not overwhelmed!) during times of social interaction, for example, tea and coffee time? How is that culture achieved?
- What conclusions do you draw from your discussions around how Our People can have an impact on the welcome and inclusion of children and their families?
